#### Power of the Month: Divine Will

"Will is the decision-making, direction, choosing faculty of the mind. It is our capacity to say "yes" or "no" to opportunities and options. The highest expression of will is willingness, conscious consent to the will of God."

Aligning our will with the Will of God is requiring. It asks you to come to believe in the absolute goodness, love, power and wisdom of God. A kind of willingness to let go of our own will (willfulness) to seek the Divine Will usually requires a tested faith. Discovering that your own will often didn't work out well, maybe even horribly, opens the door to seeking a Will immensely greater than your own.
