Hi, All My Friends and Seekers,

Let me ask you, seriously, have you found that breaking up with what you want and what you believe is hard to do? I have! Even now, after all these years of being a spiritual seeker, letting go and letting God handle the outcome is hard to do. Seeing things differently, changing my mind takes a leap of faith. Yet, faith isn't faith until I can do that. I know that and I bet you do, too. Call it what it is—fear. Fear has all kinds of hiding places that want to convince you to embrace the status quo.

Any kind of fear is a block to tasting the nectar of thriving. Fear abides in our beliefs about money, health, relationships, intimacy, or our capacities. It also hides in not wanting to enter the unknown. As long as they are unacknowledged, they run the show in some mischievous way. That fact gave me a metaphorical black eye more than once.

There is a way to push through that kind of thinking, though. That is the great experiment that will usher us into the holidays. Can you imagine being fearless, such that you are willing to try new things, to see



something differently, to give up being right, to stop playing it safe, or sticking with the tried and true?

Take my son, Ed. He is absolutely amazing in so many ways. At 5 years old, when the tide was at its lowest point, he and my dad would descend the dock at my parents' home in Florida and walk along the sand so Eddie could pick up little crabs for my mom to cook. He'd hang the crabs on his shirt. At only 11 years old, he connected wires and hung speakers to create surround-sound in our family room. I could go on but let me just say he fed a passion for many things in courageous ways—faithful ways.

The irony is that he does not have a passion for change. Not too long ago, he was being pursued by a mortgage lending company. He enjoyed a very successful 15 or so years as a lender with Bank of America. The new company wanted him so much they flew him to Chicago to meet the president. No go. A year later, calls were coming in from VPs in

Rosa Parks, after daring to fly in the face of custom, said, "I have learned that when one's mind is made up, this diminishes fear; knowing what must be done does away with fear."

Note that she said that after not giving up her seat on the bus, not before. The same is true for you and me. Bold action is the antidote to healing fear—false evidence appearing real! Do it for the sake of a greater, new sense of thriving.
