We're planning on five Enrichment Circles this year: three during business hours and two in the evenings. Small group signup forms will be available September 3.

World Day of Prayer

This year's theme for Unity's World Day of Prayer, which begins with an opening ceremony at Unity Village on Wednesday evening, September 13 and culminates in a 24-hour prayer vigil on September 14, is "*Heart of Healing*." Then plan to join us in the Sanctuary (using the garden door rather than the main entrance) from Noon to 1pm Thursday, September 14th, for a personal prayer vigil.
